The Jontek Foundation focuses on projects of national impact in Switzer-land

The Jontek Foundation considers any narrative medium: text, sound, film, photography, multimedia, infographic, graphic novel, game, augmented reality, and all media of the future.

The Jontek Foundation supports at least once a year a project with CHF 24'000. It fosters the developing of the content. Production costs such as printing, programming or postproduction are not covered.

The Jontek Foundation aims to cover 10-50% of the project's budget for research and development.

The Jontek Foundation does not accept grant applications. Projects are found by the members of the Advisory Board or are brought to the Foundation from their environment.

The Jontek Foundation also enables the accompanying by a mentor: An expert can be mandated as sparring partner for the funded project with a maximum of 24 hours at CHF 100. These costs are covered by the Jontek Foundation as well.

The Jontek Foundation has been launched in 2023. Behind the foundation is Koni Nordmann, who pursued social documentary projects himself as a photojournalist and publisher.

The Jontek Foundation is accompanied by an advisory board: Koni Nordmann, Nadine Olonetzky, Andreas Vogel and Silvia Schönfelder.

The Jontek Foundation is tax-exempt and belongs to the Bernese umbrella foundation FONTES. It is guided by the principles and recommendations of the 'Swiss Foundation Code'.
